| The Asian American Physicians' Association   | 1 Nov.   | 1-\$500 will be given to a MCHS student who has a GPA = 3.5+ and someone who has participated in extra-curricular activities and community service. | Toyota Community Scholars  | 5 Nov.   | \$10,000-\$20,000 for one MCHS student with an outstanding academic record who is a leader and has a well-documented record of service both within and outside of MCHS. While academic performance is a prime factor in the selection process, it is important to note that the distinguishing characteristic will be the overall impact of the student's contributions in community service. | The Violet Richardson Award - Honoring Young Women for Volunteer Action (A program of Soroptimist International) | 1 Dec.   | \$1000-\$2500 for making the community and the world a better place through volunteer efforts such as: fighting drugs; crime and violence prevention; cleaning up the environment; and working to end discrimination and poverty. Volunteer actions that benefit women or girls are of particular interest.   | Pick up the application in the CCC office  |
| Boston University - Trustee Scholarship Competition  | 1 Dec.   | \$32,000 a year for 4 years if you are in the top 1-3% of the class and you are active in school and in the community.  | Sign up in the CCC.  |
| American Architect Foundation Minority and Disadvantage Scholarship  | 8 Dec. by the counselor, or by person nominating you | Offers minority and disadvantage students scholarships in order to encourage diversity and equity in the architectural profession. For seniors who plan to study architecture at a NAAB-accredited program. 2 parts of application. Student has to be nominated by either a high school guidance counselor, architect, or someone who is aware of student's interest or aptitude in architecture. | Martin Luther King Jr. Scholar Program - Ithaca College (New York)   | 10 Dec.  | Full tuition & a scholarship of \$17,000 will be given to academically talented students from underrepresented ethnic or racial backgrounds. You'll be conducting research, travel and take part in service projects. You should be in top 10% of class and your SAT 1 (verbal & math only) = 1200.   | Application in the CCC.  |

| National Society of Daughters of the American Revolution-Dr.Aura Lee A. and James Hobbs Pittenger American History Scholarship | 1 Feb. | \$2000 each year to a senior who will have concentrated study of a minimum of 24 credit hours in American History or American Government. | The University of British Columbia   | 1 Feb. | \$14,000-\$34,000 (depending on financial circumstances). This award is for students who are neither Canadian citizens nor permanent residents of Canada. Only ONE MCHS student may be nominated for this award.
